Please be advised these notices are for the Bigstone Cree Nation and MD of Opportunity areas of Wabasca and Calling Lake only.

PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT BIGSTONE STILL HAS 3 ACTIVE CASES

A NEW CASE REPORTED IN CALLING LAKE WHICH MEANS THERE ARE NOW 2 ACTIVE CASES.

NOTE: ALTHOUGH THE MAP HAS DIFFERENT NUMBERS, OUR PUBLIC HEALTH TEAM IS ADVISED AND FOLLOWS UP ON ACTIVE CASES.

REGARDLESS OF NUMBER OF CASES IN THE COMMUNITIES, PLEASE KNOW IT IS HERE AND WE NEED TO TAKE THE PUBLIC HEALTH MEASURES SERIOUSLY.

These notices are to advise community members to take active measures to limit the spread of Covid-19. The Bigstone Public health team is busy with contact tracing and assisting those with wellness checks that are to self-isolate. Please be aware that self-isolation should be followed and if those not following the public health measures will be notified and enforcement actions will take place.

For those under self-isolation, we have services available so you can remain at home. If you were notified to self-isolate, you were handed documentation of what the guidelines are. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the public health departments in Wabasca and Calling Lake.

It can be difficult for some to self-isolate so let us provide support for them. It could be a phone call to let them know they are supported. It could help ease their anxiety, depression and loneliness as they deal with the isolation. We don't want to make them feel criticized or overwhelmed by comments pointed at them.

If you have any concerns or need clarification on Covid-19 you can call the Bigstone Health Commission and speak to our public health team, the health director and the CEO to answer any of your questions.
