



COMMUNITY CONSULTATIVE GROUP (CCG)

Require the following:

2 YOUTH BOARD MEMBERS (1 Female/1 Male – ages up to 25yrs.)

The Community Consultative Group falls under the Tri-partite Agreement between Canada Solicitor General, Alberta Solicitor General and Bigstone Cree Nation

CCG is made up of members selected from the community and it ensures that the policing interests of the community are well represented. Its role is to identify and advocate for BCN community policing priorities. Among other duties, it promotes dialogue and good communication between the police service and the community.

Responsibilities of CCG include:

- Identify policing issues and concerns and seek solutions by communicating with Wabasca/Desmarais RCMP Detachment, First Nations Community Policing Service FNCPS, Bigstone Cree Nation Chief & Council and departments.
- The Community Consultative Group meets monthly. Special meetings or training sessions of the CCG may be called at anytime for specific purposes as well.

Qualifications:

- BCN community members who are living healthy lifestyles and are concerned and well aware of the problems in all areas in the community, including safety and matters that require police attention.
